### **Objects of the Society**

To promote the advancement of nature photography in New Zealand. Nature photography to us means all aspects of the natural environment, including landscapes, flora and fauna, and close-up photography. To promote friendship, cooperation and the exchange of information and ideas about nature photography among the members of the Society both within New Zealand and overseas

### **Code of Ethics**

Nature photographers pursue their interest, because they appreciate the value of the natural world. They will, through their actions, encourage all who participate in the enjoyment of nature, to do so in a way that best promotes good stewardship of the natural resources.

This includes not interfering with wildlife and respecting their space.

You are requested to consider your lens choice to minimise disruption to their lives.

Avoid damaging or interfering with fragile environments and resist imposing at vulnerable times like breeding season.

The Nature Photography Society of New Zealand Inc. began with small enquiries in the mid 1980's among participants of Peter Harper's photography programme at the University of Canterbury. This culminated in a meeting on 20<sup>th</sup> November 1993 where the 'pathfinders', Peter & Lynda Harper, Laurie Rose, Stephen Wright, Anita Henderson, Bruce Stead, Paul Kennedy, Jim Harding, and Derek Hearn fully discussed the aims, the rules, membership, meeting places, subscriptions and so forth. Four months later, on the 26<sup>th</sup> of March 1994, the Society was officially launched. About 55 people attended the first meeting to elect officers of the Society, ratify the rules and pay their dues \$80 for foundation members and \$35 for ordinary membership.

The first committee was President: Peter Harper, Vice President: Bruce Stead, Secretary: Stephen Wright, Treasurer: Laurie Rose, Committee: Derek Hearn, Jim Harding, Richard Studholme, Lynda Harper, Paul Kennedy. The club became an Incorporated Society on 29<sup>th</sup> April 1994. It was first called the Festival of Photography (Image New Zealand) Inc. but changed the name on 5<sup>th</sup> May 1994.

In April 1994 there were 33 paid up members, 29 of which were foundation members. The first monthly meeting was held in June at the Chinese Cathedral but, because it was rather a cold place, a new venue was found in Kilmore Street at the Canterbury Employers Building. The first field trip was to Mt Grey on the 8<sup>th</sup> may and then to Cass for the first of many wonderful trips staying at the University Research Facility on the 29<sup>th</sup>-31<sup>st</sup> July.

In 2024 we have 148 members, 6 of them life members, Peter Harper, Judy Ashton, Jane Coulter, Ken Muscroft-Taylor, Pol Syrett and Kath Varcoe. Sadly, two life members have died, Stephen Wright and Carl Thompson.

History of the Nature Photography Society of New Zealand - It all started ...Peter Harper

Hmmm. It all started because photo students from my classes wanted to stay in touch after their classes finished. So, in 1993 we had a meeting at our home in Taylors Ave. Stephen, Laurie Rose, Carl, Paul Kennedy, Lynda and I met to discuss the matter. Can't remember whether Bruce Stead or Richard Studholme were there - there weren't many as I recall. The original idea came from Laurie Rose, I became the founding president for quite a few years as I recall. The official legal birth of the Society was 13 January 1994.

Anyway, we convened a meeting at Okeover (in March 1994 I think) in which 63 people came. Basil O'Connor kept the very first minutes on a piece of paper and a pencil. Laurie Rose worked on making us an Incorporated Society - so we didn't need to pay tax, etc. so we are NOT a club - we are truly an incorporated society.

When we called for subs to the new society, 32 members who paid \$80 became Foundation Members, and many of these remain. In Sep 1994 we had 32 foundation members and 31 ordinary members (annual sub was \$35).

1994 Program - from Gaynor Brown's diary

Noted in the diary is a meeting for the 26 March at 8.00pm at Okeover, Centre for Continuing Education -Nature Photography Society of N.Z. -as a foundation member contribution of \$80. On March 12 prior to this meeting there was a weekend trip to Kaikoura - I think to plan for the trip to Turkey. I picked up Edith. Looking further back I see we had drinks at Judy Ashton's on 4 February.

Looking through notes made on the series of lectures we attended in preparation for the trip to Turkey and the Greek islands, I note that the lectures ran through every week from October 1993 to December 1993. Possibly there was discussion re setting up a continuing photographic nature group at any one of those times. Definitely the first date of 26 March 1994 was the initial setting up date.

We flew to Singapore on 20 April 1994 and were in Istanbul on the 22 May. I continued on through Italy, Holland and Denmark and left Copenhagen on 8 June.

The next date I have for a Nature Photography meeting was 20 June at the Chinese Cultural Hall. The next meeting was at the Chinese Cultural Centre on 18 July and Don Hadden spoke on Wildlife Photography.

July 30 -there was a field trip to Cass.

15 August - the meeting was at Kilmore Street.

This was followed by meeting in September on the 19th at Kilmore Street.

25 September -a field trip to Gore Bay with Nature photography and Laurel McDonald and Judy Ashton were with me.

Next meeting was 17 October.

November 21- Colin Monteath presented on Antarctic Photography.

December 3 - a field trip to Arthurs Pass and Temple Basin led by Derek Hearn.

12 December -a Christmas get together.
